- Site boundary and existing fences
  - - - Timber edging (flush with ground unless otherwise noted)
  - [Concrete symbol] Concrete
  - [Gravel symbol] Gravel or pebbles (eg max 14mm diameter river pebbles)
  - [Rock symbol] Rock garden
  - [Permeable symbol] Permeable pavement to carport and driveway (clients' choice)
  - [Steps symbol] Proposed steps (numbers indicative as levels unknown)
  - [Manhole symbol] Manhole cover
  - [Tap symbol] Tap
  - [Wheelie bin symbol] Wheelie bins
  - [Feature pots symbol] Feature pots

Fire pit. Base at existing ground level. Perimeter about 450mm high for comfortable seating. Perhaps concrete block walls, rendered & painted to match raised beds near water tank. Timber slat bench seat on top.

Feng shui feature required to compensate for house's missing wealth corner eg moving water feature, beautiful sculpture or plant pot (with healthy plant!) - something that represents health and abundance.

optional: this entire edge from carport to chook pen could be raised

Brick or rendered block-work raised garden bed to height of brick house foundations (and same colour). Smaller raised bed to north = height just below main deck

leave open to allow for possible future room (house extension)

possible extra water tank off carport roof

hedge of shade-loving plants

carport roof over. Roof angle to complement house
